



Active Kids Camp Code of Conduct

Camp Coach Counselors

1. Coaches will demonstrate a safe and positive environment at Camp. This includes exercising positive self-control, graciously accepting the outcome of the games and treating all campers and coaches with courtesy and respect.
2. Coaches will demonstrate respect for each other, campers, and staff members in behavior and language. Profanity will not be tolerated.
3. Violence and abuse of any nature will not be tolerated.
4. Coaches will follow the Mac's procedure when a camper's behavior is unacceptable.

Children

1. Campers will demonstrate positive sportsmanship at Camp. This includes exercising positive self-control, graciously accepting the outcome of the games and treating all campers and coaches with courtesy and respect.
2. Campers will demonstrate respect for each other, coaches, and staff members in behavior and language. Profanity will not be tolerated.
3. Violence and abuse of any nature will not be tolerated.

Parents

1. All children must be registered online and agreed to our Waiver and Code of Conduct.
2. All Children must be signed in at drop off and signed out at pick up.
3. Drop off starts 15 minutes before camp starts.
4. Children must be picked up by the end time of camp. We do not offer extended time.
5. We do not refund for camp days not used. We offer flexibility to move a date to a future date within the season. In order to move a date at no charge we need 24 hour notice.

The MAC reserves the right to refuse any child into our Active Kids Camp program based on unacceptable behavior that disrupts our Camp.

The MAC's Bad Behavior Procedure

If a child has demonstrated bad behavior, the following procedures will be enforced

1. The Camp Coach will give a verbal warning to the child to correct the bad behavior and encourage them to make better choices.
2. If behavior continues, they will be asked to leave the activity with another verbal warning.
3. If behavior continues, they are sent to the office for a time out with the MAC Manager.
4. If behavior continues, we call home and the child must be picked up early.
5. Second day of bad behavior: A call home with an early pick up with a warning they have one more chance before suspension
6. 3rd day of bad behavior: A call home, early pick up, and suspension from the remaining days of camp.

I have read and understand the above Code of Conduct and understand that the expectations apply to behavior at the MAC. I agree to abide by the Code guidelines for Active Kids Camp. I understand that if I do not follow this Code of Conduct, my child may be asked to leave the activity, a call home for an early pick up, or a suspension to attend future camps.
